If you become unemployed

Unemployment

Register at Arbetsförmedlingen (The Public Employment Service) on the first day of your unemployment. Otherwise, you may not be eligible for certain benefits. Use the QR code to obtain information about Arbetsförmedlingen.

Work permits and the right of residence

If you are a citizen of a non-EU/EEA country, and have a work permit in Sweden, your permit, and thus your right of residence in Sweden, may be affected should you lose your job. Use the QR code to find out more about work permit rules from the Swedish Migration Agency.

Unemployment benefits

As a member of a-kassan (The Unemployment Insurance Fund) you may qualify for benefits if you become unemployed. Your entitlement to benefits depend on the length of time you worked and been a member of a-kassan. Use the QR code to access IF Metall's unemployment insurance fund.

Social insurance

You may be entitled to compensation via the Swedish social insurance system. The benefits you can apply for depend on whether you live in Sweden, work here or receive Swedish unemployment benefits. Use the QR code to go to Försäkringskassan (The Swedish Social Insurance Agency).

Collective agreement coverage

Your collective agreement provides some insurance coverage for those who have been made redundant. Use the QR code to find out more about insurances and contractual pensions.

Support from TSL

Your collective agreement can also give you the opportunity for advice and other transition support to get a new job. Use the QR code for more information from Trygghetsfonden, TSL.

Membership

As a member of IF Metall, you can be covered by extra income insurance if you have been a member for 12 months. As a member you also have additional insurances. Use the QR code to find out more.
